

DATES FOR MAIL BALLOT OR BOND ELECTIONS 2010

Jan. 1-Feb. 16, 2010 (assuming there are townships within the school district that have elections March 9.)

March 9 (in conjunction with township elections)

March 30-July 9

Aug. 10 (in conjunction with primary elections)

Nov. 2 (in conjunction with General Election Day)

Dec. 13-Dec. 31 (excluding Christmas Day)

Notes:

1. You must have a 53-day notification to your county auditors before any election date is set and must get approval of bond issues through the Minnesota Department of Education's review and comment division.
2. Only districts in Statutory Operating Debt or districts conducting a mail ballot election can have an operating referendum election on a date other than the General Election.
